- **!** In essential beliefs We have unity.
 - "How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity". Psalms 133:1 "There is one Body and one Spirit...there is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, and one God and Father of us all." Eph. 4:4-6
- **!** In non-essential beliefs We have Liberty.

"Accept him whose faith is weak, without passing judgment on disputable matters..." Though Everything is permissible, not everything is beneficial", "Our liberty should not be used to satisfy the sinful nature, but to serve God." - **Bible** ~ **Is the inspired infallible Word of God** 2 Timothy 3:16, 1 Peter 1:25, 2 Peter 1:21.
- <u>God</u> ~
 - One (Trinity) God revealed as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Matthew 28:19, John 1:14, Acts 5:3-4, 2 Corinthians 13:14, Colossians 1:15-20, Hebrews 1:1-3, Revelation 1:4-6

 - o Born of a virgin birth and the deity of Jesus Christ, that He was fully God and fully man. Matthew 1:23, John 1:14

 Genesis 1:27, Romans 3:23
 - o Is born in a sinful state, man's morals are debased and that we are spiritually dead separated from and without God. ∼ Romans 3:23, Ephesians 2:4-5, 13

- Ordinances ~ Observances instituted by Jesus
 - Baptism ~ As a commandment, by immersion in the name of the Lord as an ordinance. Matthew 28:19, Acts 2:38, Acts 10:48
 - o The Lord's Supper (communion). Luke 22:20, 1 Corinthians 11:24-26
- Holy Spirit ~
 - The fruits of the spirit beginning at conversion. Some fruits of a spirit lead life are immediate, but like any fruit, is also developed as we grow spiritually. Romans 12:2, Galatians 5:-16-23, Ephesians 4:29-31, 5:1-5
 - o The baptism in the Holy Spirit, an experience that is for all Believers. It can be simultaneous to or following conversion, with the purpose of empowerment & edification of the body of Christ through Spiritual Gifts. Acts 1:5, 1:8, 10:44, 19:16, 1 Corinthians 12:1-11
- Healing ~ The divine healing power of Jesus Christ to heal the sick in answer to the prayer of faith. –
 Mark 16:17, James 5:14-16
- <u>Church</u> ~ There's no greater privilege on earth, than to be a part of "The Church" which is sacred & Holy. It's our duty to identify ourselves with a congregation of believers to build up & and to model Christian values. Acts 16:5, Ephesians 5:22-32, Hebrews 10:24-25 & Psalms 84:10.
